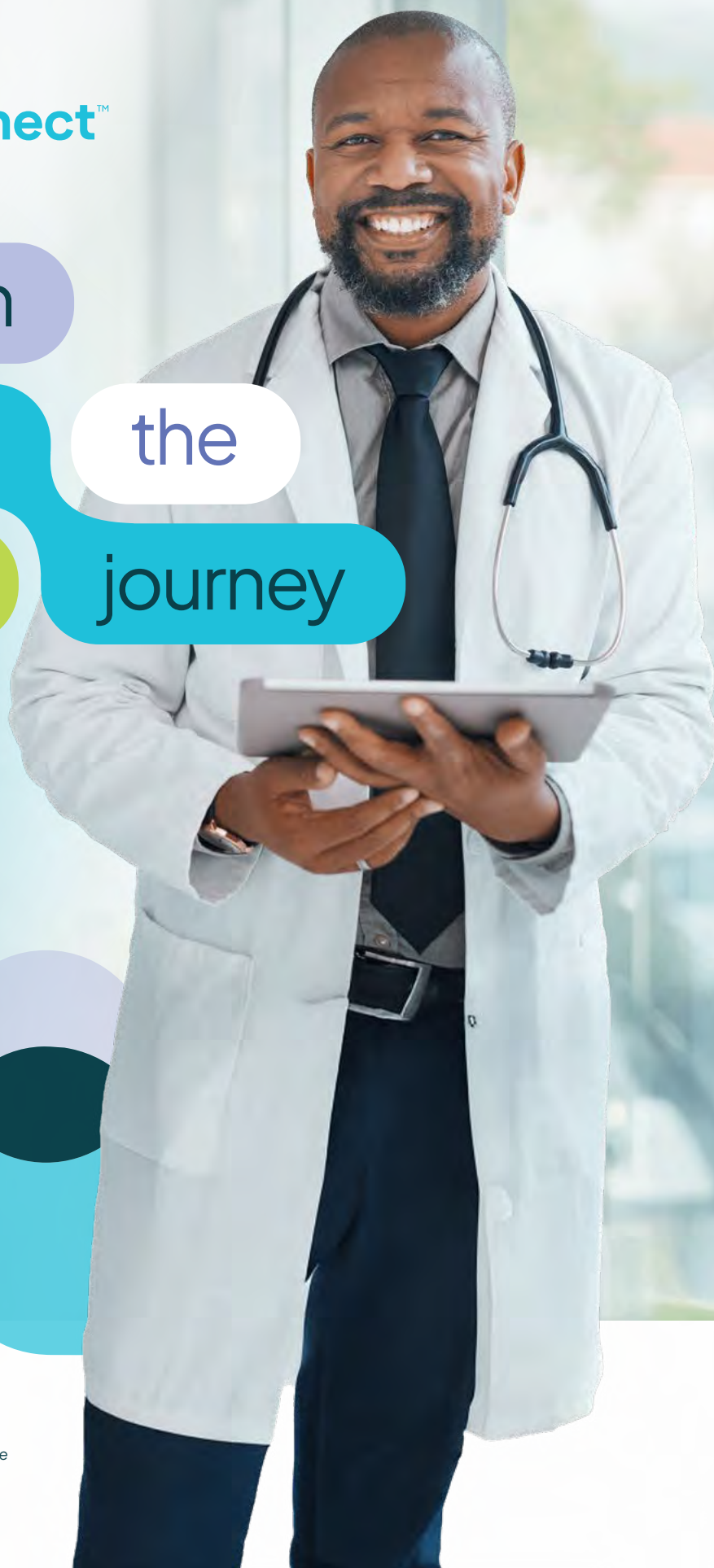

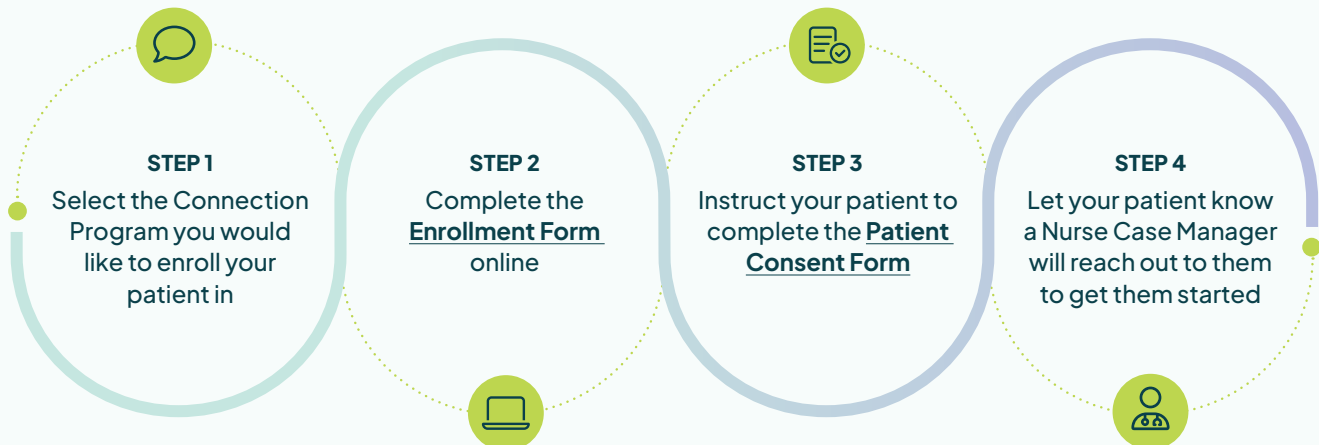
Patient Assistance Program (PAP)
